"The beautiful, lush greenery in the window view is brought inside throughout the space - a large plant anchors one corner of the dining room, a grand orchid makes a stunning vignette out of the dining table and chandelier and plants on the console/mirror vignette add depth and character to the design," Lewis explained.

Throughout the space, light greens and creams come together in a variety of patterns to create the whimsical-meets-traditional atmosphere of the room, and the window seat serves as a bright focal point for the space.
